



"Domaine Cavalier is located within the Château de Lascaux vineyards, all around a Cévenol traditional house. The blend of grape varieties of this wine allows to obtain a unique identity while letting the terroir express itself."



Origin :

At the north of Languedoc, the IGP Saint-Guilhem-le-Désert is located on a wide natural area, between Mediterranean hills and limestone high plains. The vines of Domaine Cavalier are planted on a limestone and sandy-loam soils, at the heart of a garrigue and surrounded by Aleppo pines, green oak trees and heather. At the limit of Brouzet and Corconne, the climate is cooler and gives to the grapes an optimal maturation.

Cultivation mode :

The vineyard has been certified in organic farming since 2009 and in biodynamic farming since 2018. We are particularly attached to the rich natural environment that surrounds us. By the use of composts, medicinal plant preparations, silica and horn manure, we work to enrich the fertility and the biodiversity of our soils, in order to reveal all the potential and the expression of Pic Saint-Loup in our wines.

Average age of the vines : 35 years

Density : 5000 feet / ha

Yield : 44 hl / ha

Grape varieties :

Cabernet Sauvignon : 40% Syrah : 30%
Merlot : 15% Mourvèdre : 15%

Winemaking & Aging :

Harvest by machine. Grapes are destemmed. Traditional winemaking with short maceration of 3 to 4 days followed by alcoholic fermentation during 10 days. Temperature control during the winemaking process. Aging in concrete tanks during 5 to 6 months.
