



"Domaine Cavalier is located within the Château de Lascaux vineyard, all around a Cévenol traditional house. The blend of grape varieties of this wine allows to obtain a unique identity while letting the terroir express itself."

Origin :

At the north of Languedoc, the IGP Saint-Guilhem-le-Désert is located on a wide natural area, between Mediterranean hills and limestone high plains. The vines of Domaine Cavalier are planted on a limestone and sandy-loam soils, at the heart of a garrigue and surrounded by Aleppo pines, green oak trees and heather. At the limit of Brouzet and Corconne, the climate is cooler and gives to the grapes an optimal maturation.

Cultivation mode :

The vineyard has been certified in organic farming since 2009 and in biodynamic farming since 2018. We are particularly attached to the rich natural environment that surrounds us. By the use of composts, and plant-based preparations (horsetail, nettle, chamomile, yarrow...), silica and horn dung, we work to enrich the fertility and the biodiversity of our soils, in order to reveal all the potential and the expression of Pic Saint-Loup in our wines.

Average age of the vines : 15 years

Density : 6200 feet / ha

Yield : 33 hl / ha

Grape varieties :

Sauvignon : 40% Viognier : 30% Rolle : 20% Petit Manseng : 10%

Winemaking & Aging :

Harvest in the morning. The grapes are destemmed. Selection of free-run juice and pressed juice. Cold settling. Natural yeasts. Temperature control around 15°C during the winemaking process. Aging in stainless steel tanks. Bottled at end of February.
